### **SWRA RSES Auxiliary Honorary Member**

Established:

February 10, 2007 San Antonio, TX to be awarded the first time in Fort Worth, TX 2008

Objective:

This is a Regional award presented to a member who has been active in the SWRA Regional Auxiliary for not less than 20 years and is currently a member in good standing.

Award:

- Plaque for individual recipient to be presented at Regional Conference to include name and year.
- The SWRA Auxiliary will pay the International Auxiliary and SWRA Auxiliary dues for the award recipient.
- The Vice-President will be responsible for obtaining the plaque, having it engraved, and coordinating the award activities. At least three (3) plaques are to be available for engraving at all times. The Treasurer will determine which trophy shop makes the original plaques.

Committee:

The current Regional President shall appoint a Chairperson and two (2) Auxiliary members to serve as the award Committee.

Requirements for participation:

Current Regional R.S.E.S.A. members in good standing with at least 20 years longevity are eligible.

Recipient decision:

The Committee Chairperson shall determine the committee meeting place and time at the Annual Conference. Any nomination submitted shall be subject to a 2/3 majority vote of the committee.

Procedure for nominating:

The nominee must have actively participated in the Regional Auxiliary by:

- (A) Assisting in Annual Conference planning and hosting.
- (B) Serving on an appointed committee
- (C) Been a Secretary in their chapter and participated in the Regional Officer nomination process.
- (D) Served as a Regional Officer.

**At least two (2) of the preceding criteria must be met before a nomination will be considered.**

- (E) Nomination must be via a letter from a member in good standing of the Regional Auxiliary.
- (F) All letters must be sent to every member of the committee.
- (G) Deadline for the committee to receive information is February 1<sup>st</sup>.

Presentation:

To be presented by the Committee Chairperson or a member in good standing appointed by the Chairperson at the Auxiliary Luncheon.
