**Pauline Becker Outstanding Member Award**

Established:

February 11, 1989

Objective:

To recognize an outstanding individual for their significant and personal achievements in the Region.

Award:

- Plaque with the name of the recipient, Chapter name, city, and year to be kept and displayed at Regional Conferences.
- Plaque for individual recipient to be presented at Regional Conference to include name, Chapter, and year.
- The Vice-President will be responsible for obtaining the plaque, having it engraved, and coordinating the award activities.

Committee:

The immediate Past President will serve as Chairperson of this Committee. The committee will include the three (3) immediate Past Presidents and the current Vice-President.

Requirements for participation:

Each member of the regional R.S.E.S.A. is eligible.

Recipient decision:

To be determined by the Committee, by secret ballot, at the Annual Conference. This will not necessarily be awarded each year.

Procedure for nominating:

- (A) Individual must be a member in good standing of the International Society and the Regional Auxiliary.
- (B) They must be nominated via a letter from a member of the Regional Auxiliary or a member of the Regional R.S.E.S.
- (C) All letters must be sent to every member of the committee.
- (D) Deadline for the committee to receive information is February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- (E) Nominating / Recommendation letter should stress Regional Achievements.
